

## **FAQ Fall Soccer 2009**

### **1. When do we register?**

Registration is open from now – July 31<sup>st</sup>. Fees will increase by \$25 dollars after this date. Team formation will take place on August 5<sup>th</sup>. Players will be placed on teams on a first come first served basis. You will be notified ASAP if your child was not placed on a team because of space limitations.

### **2. What season does the fall registration cover?**

All players that are placed on a team in the fall will continue with the same team in the spring. Players in levels U7 to U14 recreational are required to “re-register” in the spring and pay a fee of \$30. Teams will remain the same for the spring season.

### **3. How do we register?**

MSC is encouraging to “go green” and register online. You can find the registration link on our website. [www.maumellesoccer.com](http://www.maumellesoccer.com). You can pay by credit card or check. Your child will not be placed on a team until payment is received. Paper registration forms are available at the Maumelle Community Center however there is an additional fee to register with a paper form of \$25.00. Returning players should have received an e-mail with a username and password assigned to your player. ### **4. When does the fall season begin and end?**

Our Fall Soccer season will begin on Saturday, September 6 and usually last for 8 weeks.

### **5. How will we know what team we are on?**

Once the teams have been formed, MSC will notify the coaches, and the coaches will notify the players.

### **6. When will my team practice?**

The team coaches and our field coordinator will decide practice schedules. MSC will also offer some academy style practice sessions, in which everyone in a certain age group will practice together. This is designed so that all players are receiving the same skill development. Academy practice schedules will be determined at a later date and notification will follow.

## 8. How do I become a coach?

When you register online, there is a specific question that asks you if you would like to coach. MSC would encourage anyone interested to join our volunteer coaches. There are classes available in which coaches can attend to earn different levels of coaching qualifications. You can contact anyone on the MSC board and we will be happy to assist you.

## 9. I missed the registration deadline date of July 31<sup>s</sup>, can my child still play?

Maumelle Soccer Club will do everything it can to ensure that anybody that wants to play soccer – can. If you register late, your child will be wait-listed and added to a team if possible. There is a \$25 late fee charge to cover the extra cost of ordering uniforms late and adding players to rosters after the deadline.

**10. Why do you charge so much to play soccer?  
(What does MSC do with the registration money?)**

Currently our rates are one of the cheapest in the state averaging 50% to 60% of what other clubs charge. The major part of your registration fees go toward: uniforms, state registration, referees, field maintenance, and our director of coaching. This year your fee goes towards the fall season only and it will cost you only \$30.00 to return for the spring season.
